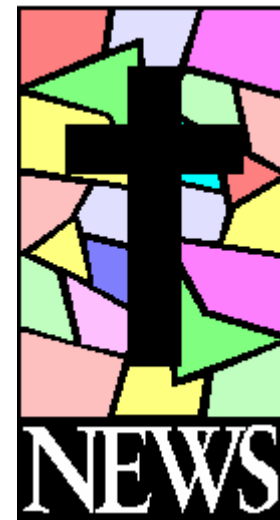

Revelation. “He hath showed thee, O man, what is good.” How valuable it is to know what is good. It is the difference between life and death. God reveals to us by many ways what is good. But nothing shows us what is good better than the Word of God. Get into the Word to learn what is good.

Requirements. “What does the Lord require of thee, but to do justly, and to love mercy, and to walk humbly with thy God.” Three requirements are given man here. They involve our being conscientious, compassionate and consecrated.

First conscientious. “Do justly.” Summed up this means to be honest and truthful with man and God.

Second compassionate. “Love mercy.”

Third consecrated. “Walk humbly with God.” This means submission to God, fellowship with God, devotion to God, worship God, and service for God. Walking humbly with God is one of the keys to real joy.

Note! Do you want to read some really good books? If you have not read Rick Warren’s THE PURPOSE DRIVEN LIFE and THE PURPOSE DRIVEN CHURCH then you might think about doing so. They are excellent reading (not dull or hard to follow). They really can give great insight for your life (What does the Lord require of thee?) and the life of our church.
